

**MOTORSPORT IRELAND (“MI”)
Action (A) Decisions (D) and Communications (C)
made at meeting of the Motorsport Council (“MSC”)
held on the 24th September 2019
at The Royal Irish Automobile Club, 34 Dawson Street, Dublin 2**

- C RC1 **Appendix 90, Rule 5** was agreed.
- D Some MSC meetings may be replaced by meetings between the Chairs of the Commissions and Sub-commissions
- C A proposal to hold regular regional committee meetings will be explored further.
- C A Women’s Commission is to be formed.
- C Ronnie Murphy has been hired as a new Safety and Training Officer for Motorsport Ireland. He comes from the GAA
- C MIS will be sponsoring the Champions Awards Lunch.
- C All rescue crews have completed Rescue training. A demonstration of proposed new fire extinguishers has taken place. FETAC level 6 Safety Officer Training course has been completed for 2019. Another course will run in 2020. Over 250 00 Safety Car Training will take place in November.
- C A Rally Competitors’ meeting will take place on 25th September.
- C Conor McCormack has resigned from the Kart Committee. Eoghan Briody was ratified by the Council as his replacement. The last karting event of the season has been held with 89 entries. Last year the entry for the same event was 45.
- C The Council ratified Pauline Fielding as a new member of the Volunteers and Officials Commission. Noel Byrne was approved by the Council as a permanent member of the Marshals Sub-commission.
