made at meeting of the Motorsport Council (“MSC”)
Held at 7.30pm. on the 26th of February 2019
at The Royal Irish Automobile Club, 34 Dawson Street, Dublin 2

- C. MI Membership is to be promoted across the sport.
- C. Nial Murphy has been elected Vice President of the Motorsport Council.
- D. The following RC1s have been agreed by the Motorsport Council:
 - RC1 Appendix 88.2 Scrutiny
 - App.25 Art 3
 - Rule 29 Section 1
 - 29.1 Class 25 (approved with an amendment)
 - App 31 Art 3,4,5
- C. The Dates Application cut off has been confirmed as the 23rd of April. Post-dated cheques will be due on the 21st June. The final Calendar will be agreed at the July CAC.
- C. Team Ireland hosted a day in Tynagh in January for all eight candidates of the 2018 Billy Coleman award and for their co-drivers.
- C. Motorsport Ireland’s GDPR Policy is now on the website. Clubs and their GDPR policy will be added to the agenda for the next CAC meeting.
- C. The FIA has set up a Drift Commission and plans to run a Drifting World Series
- C. Motorsport Ireland supported The Alliance for Insurance Reform in 2018 and plans to do so again in 2019 as they continue to campaign for insurance reform in Ireland.
- C. There are plans for female competition licence holders to hold a meeting in the RIAC with a view to promoting women in motorsport.
- C. Five Marshall Training Days have been scheduled to date this year.
- C. The Tracking system had been used for the first time at the Birr Stages Rally and had been well received. There are plans to produce videos on the correct use of harnesses.
- C. The FIA are holding a Safety seminar on Rallying in early March and the Motorsport Ireland Safety Commission will be making a presentation on Drivers’ Briefings and on Safety Plans.
