Action (A) Decisions (D) and Communications (C) made at meeting of the Motorsport Council (“MSC”) Held at 7.30pm. on the 8th of January 2019 at The Royal Irish Automobile Club, 34 Dawson Street, Dublin 2

- A CEO to circulate a generic confidentiality agreement for members of all Commissions to sign.
- C Election of President: John Naylor.
- D Agreement to derogation under the new rule in Appendix 110; 5.2.4 to allow Chairman of the Trials Commission, to act as Clerk of the Course at Sporting Trial events during the year.
- C MI Membership
MSC to use their influence and connections to encourage and recognise ALL the people in motorsport who don't have a licence but are a part of the motorsport family and we should recognise as members.
- C Dates for MSC this year.

MSC Dates for 2019:

8th January, 26th February, 26th March, 23rd April, 28th May, 25th June, 23rd July, 24th September, 22nd October, 26th November and 10th December.

The dates application cut off will be the 23rd of April.
First dates meeting will be on the 7th of May.
Post-dated cheques for the 1st January 2020 must be in by the 21st of June. The final calendar will be agreed on the 2nd of July.
The cut-off date for the yearbook will be the 1st of October.

- D Funding for accredited independent safety training proposed by the Safety Commission for Safety Officers agreed.
