



## MOTORSPORT IRELAND RACE COMMISSION

**Actions, Decisions and Communications made at meeting of the Race Commission held at Motorsport Ireland Dawson Street @.8pm on the 17<sup>th</sup> of October 2019.**

**Location: Motorsport Ireland Dawson Street.**

Action	Request the MI office to publish in a timely fashion the results of the Tribunals of Appeals. Some held earlier this year have not been published yet.
Decision	RC1 update to GCR 150.7 changing wording to apply a minimum 3 month ban or until points reach their 12 month life. RC1 sent to Rules Group;
Action	Race Commission secretary to send email to all the Racing completors informing them of an Open Forum in RIAC on the 28 <sup>th</sup> November at 8pm.
Action	Race Commission secretary to write to HRCA on the requirement to have 2 rearview mirrors on Pre'55 cars.
Action	Race Secretary to write to those classes who have not nominated their Championship rounds for 2020 to ensure that we can fix the calendar at the next meeting
Action	Request the MI office to publish in a timely fashion the Stewards reports to the Race Commission Secretary so they can be reviewed at the next Commission meeting.
Decision	Request Safety Commission to review the Mondello back gate entry during a live event for safety of the operator.
Decision	The championship applications for the HRCA & Ginetta classes to be confirmed by the office as received. These have been approved in advance by the Race Commission.
Decision	Sexton trophy. Request publication of the rules and also the other candidates for same, as soon as possible. Leave maximum amount of preparation time for the interviews as possible.
Communication	Noise limits to be introduced for Mondello for 2020 108 dB max allowed. Procedures and equipment to be

Communication	Request MPSC to hold a Team Managers Meeting for the Fiesta Endurance Race as soon as possible and to inform all team manager that the pit wall will only have 2 persons per team (signaller and assistant)
