Existing Rule: 6.1.1. There are four categories of track for Kart Racing: (a) Kart Permanent: Tracks with a lap distance of less than 4500m , where the shape can be determined at any time and all protective barriers are permanently in position. (b) Kart Temporary: Tracks with a lap distance less than 4500m , where the barriers are not permanently positioned. (c) Round the Houses: Tracks using public roads or passing through residential areas or so classified by MI. (d) Long Circuits: Any Kart circuit, other than (c), exceeding 4500m in lap distance, and all licenced Motor Race Circuits.	6.1.1. There are four categories of track for Kart Racing: (a) Kart Permanent: Tracks with a lap distance of less than <u>2500m</u> , where the shape can be determined at any time and all protective barriers are permanently in position. (b) Kart Temporary: Tracks with a lap distance less than <u>2500m</u> , where the barriers are not permanently positioned. (c) Round the Houses: Tracks using public roads or passing through residential areas or so classified by MI. (d) Long Circuits: Any Kart circuit, other than (c), exceeding <u>2500m</u> in lap distance, and all licenced Motor Race Circuits.
