GCR 108.2.3. Competitor Entrant's Licence

~~All drivers with MI Junior Kart Racing Licenses, Junior Rallycross Class, Junior Race Class and Junior Rallysprint and Junior Hillelimb / Sprint must be entered and accompanied at events by the holder of a current valid Competitor Entrant's Licence, who must be 18 years of age or over. In addition, parents/guardians wishing to enter drivers who have attained 14 years and are under 18 years of age may optionally avail of this licence. It is the Entrant's responsibility to ensure that all persons concerned with the entry observe Regulations and the Sporting Regulations. If an Entrant is unable to be present in person at the Event, they must nominate their representative in writing, who must also be the holder of a current valid Competitor Entrant's Licence. Such a representative is responsible jointly and severally with the Entrant for the observation of all the rules and regulations. Entrants must ensure that their vehicles comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout practice and the race. Current fees are set out in the Schedule of Fees in these Rules. The holder of a Competitor Entrant's licence may act as Entrant for a maximum of two drivers. In the case where the parent/guardian is acting as Entrant for their own children, this restriction does not apply.~~

GCR 108.2.3. **Minor Entrant Licence**

Only one member of a crew may be under 18 years of age. All drivers and passengers under 18 years of age must be entered and accompanied at events by the holder of a current valid Minor Entrant Licence (formerly Competitor Entrant Licence). It is recommended that the Entrant is the competitor's parent or legal guardian. In the event that the Entrant is not the competitor's parent or legal guardian, they must be Garda Vetted. The holder of the Minor Entrant Licence is the entrant and the minor is the driver or passenger, if this person is not the parent or legal guardian, then the parent/legal guardian must sign an approval section allowing the Garda-vetted third party who holds a Minor Entrant licence to act as the Entrant for the minor. The holder of a Minor Entrant licence may act as an Entrant for a maximum of two drivers unless more than two drivers are their own children.

~~With the exception of the provisions of Rule 108.2.3, where a competitor has not reached their 18th birthday the Entry for an event must be endorsed by the Parent or Guardian as Guarantor. Such Guarantor will be considered as being the Minor's Entrant, and as such will be subject to these Rules.~~
